

How to Make a Tall Man

You'll need:

3 or more cardboard cylinders
masking or sticky tape
pipe cleaners, wool, strips of paper
glue, pens, paints, stapler

Using a number of cardboard cylinders we can make a tall, tall man by taping them together as shown. Leave enough wriggle room between cylinders.

Wide masking tape or wide sticky tape works best.

For his long, long arms, use different coloured pipe cleaners. Wrap around his body near the neck. Loop the ends to make hands.

Loop the ends to make hands.

For his curly, curly hair you can use strips of coloured paper, or coloured strands of wool or string. Or all three. Stick on with glue.

For his long, long legs use a long thin strip of coloured paper for each leg. Fold like a concertina, back and forth. Staple the two dangly legs on to the bottom cylinder.

Finally decorate your tall man in any way you like with paints or stickers or glitter, or pens or crayons.

Or a bit of everything!

Remember to use bright colours.
